Short Biography

Dr. Eda is an Assistant Professor of Physics and Chemistry Department at the National University of Singapore. He is also a holds a joint appointment at the Centre for Advanced 2D Materials and the Solar Energy Research Institute of Singapore. His research interest includes condensed matter phenomena in low-dimensional solids, ultra-thin film growth, and intercalation chemistry of layered compounds. He worked at Imperial College London as a Newton International Fellow of the Royal Society of UK prior to joining NUS. Dr. Eda completed B.A. in Physics at the International Christian University (Tokyo), M.S. in Materials Science and Engineering at Worcester Polytechnic Institute (MA), and Ph.D. in the same discipline at Rutgers University (NJ) in 2009. He is a recipient of the Singapore National Research Foundation (NRF) Research Fellowship and many awards including the Singapore National Academy of Science (SNAS) Young Scientist Award, University Young Researcher Award, and IPS Omicron Nanotechnology Award.
