Short Biography

Ken-ichi Fukui is a Professor in Chemistry at Osaka University, Japan. He received his Doctor of Science from the University of Tokyo in 1994. He started his career as an Assistant Professor at the University of Tokyo in 1994 and was promoted as a Lecturer in 2001. In 2002, he became an Associate Professor at Tokyo Institute of Technology and in 2008, he has moved to Osaka University to accept the present position.

His present research interests cover the microscopic mechanism of catalyses at solid surfaces/interfaces and the molecular view of electric double layer at liquid/solid interfaces for novel energy conversion. (Group website : <http://www.surf.chem.es.osaka-u.ac.jp/>)

He has also been working as an Editor of *Surface Science* since 2015.
