Short Biography

Sander Otte received his PhD from Leiden University, The Netherlands, in 2008. He was involved in pioneering experiments on inelastic spin excitations on individual atoms at IBM Research (San Jose, USA). During his postdoc at NIST (Gaithersburg, USA) he participated in the construction of a mK STM facility, and used this for the study of Landau quantization in epitaxial graphene. From 2010, Otte runs a research group at Delft University of Technology, The Netherlands (tenured 2015), focusing on assembly of atomic lattices for the purpose of studying correlated electrons.
